Develop and nurture our international alumni network.



It lies between two major rivers, the legendary Mississippi River and the Ohio River. Unlike the rest of the state, which is predominantly level farmland, Southern Illinois is known for the Shawnee National Forest, and for its scenic bluffs, rolling hills, and, more recently, for its wine and fruit production.

Students and residents take advantage of the natural beauty of the area for such activities as boating, fishing, hiking, rock climbing, and horseback riding.
